Union Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM)

#StrongerTogether since 2001



...encourage cooperation between Member States for preventing and protecting against natural or manmade disasters.

(Article 196, TFEU)





Union Civil Protection Knowledge Network

Launched in December 2021



Bring together civil protection and disaster risk management experts and organisations (partnership facilitator)



Make relevant knowledge on civil protection and disaster risk management accessible to all (knowledge broker)



Foster innovation for more efficient and effective civil protection systems (innovation catalyst)



Union disaster resilience goals

Commission Recommendation (2023/C 56/01)
Communication COM(2023) 61 final

- Non-binding goals
- Actions for both EC and MS
- Apply to civil protection area
- Focus on large scale disasters









